ENN, 2 June 2009 - New Stadium to be one of the greenest.

When the New York Jets and New York Giants kickoff their 2010 seasons, they'll be playing in one of the greenest venues in sports thanks to a partnership with the U.S. EPA. Highlights include:

- Using some 40,000 tons of recycled steel to build the stadium;
- Recycling 20,000 tons of steel when stadium is demolished;
- Building the stadium on a parcel of rehabilitated land;
- Reducing air pollution from construction vehicles by using cleaner diesel fuel and diesel engine filters;
- Using environmentally-friendly concrete in construction;
- Reducing water consumption and increasing energy efficiency;
- Providing mass transit options for fans; and
- Replacing traditional plates and cups with compostable alternatives.
